

SEPTEMBER BOOK REVIEW

With the beginning of a new school year, the memoir <u>Educated</u> by Tara Westover gives a whole new meaning to the word 'education'. Tara was born to survivalist parents in the mountains of Idaho. Her mother was a midwife and healer and her father salvaged metal for his junkyard. Her father distrusted the medical field, so Tara never saw a doctor. The family was so isolated from mainstream society that there was no one to ensure the children received an education, so Tara was seventeen the first time she set foot in a classroom.

When one of her brothers went off to college, Tara decided to try a new kind of life. She taught herself math, grammar, and science to take the ACT and was admitted to Brigham Young University. There she studied psychology, politics, philosophy, and history, learning for the first time about world events like the Holocaust and the Civil Rights Movement. Her quest for knowledge transformed her, taking her overseas to other continents, to Harvard, and to Cambridge University.

OCTOBER BOOK REVIEW

Where The Crawdads Sing by Delia Owens is the perfect mystery novel for October. The book begins with the discovery of Chase Andrews' body in Barkley Cove swamp in 1969 off the coast of North Carolina.

The story then goes back in time to 1952 to Kya Clark who is 6 years old living near the marsh with her family. However, her mother and siblings all leave her to live with her violent, alcoholic father. A truant officer tries to get her to go to school, but Kya, 'the wild Marsh girl', doesn't quite fit in so she never returns. She learns to read, though, from a friendly boy Tate Walker who lives nearby. When Kya turns 10, her father disappears so she survives by hunting, fishing, and selling mussels to the locals. She and Tate continue their friendship which develops into a romantic relationship as they get older while Kya is also being pursued by Chase Andrews, a popular local boy who has noticed how beautiful Kya has become. At 19, Tate goes off to college but promises he will find a book publisher who might be interested in Kya's nature paintings. It's now 1969 and Chase Andrews' body has been discovered so the sheriff and locals accuse 'the wild Marsh girl'.

THANKS FOR ANSWERING THE CALL


